Thank you for the opportunity to have a look at the consultation documents. I have only two comments.

Firstly there is no reference in RT06 North Environment Report Volume 1 (Appendix C - Review of Policies, Plans, Programmes) to the extant Development Plan in Snowdonia namely the Eryri Local Plan (Adopted November 1999). This contains the National Park Authority's planning policies on waste. The ELP will remain in force until it is superseded by the LDP (2010).

Secondly, and a point raised on numerous previous occasions, the Definitive Areas of Search In-Building North Map still shows an existing waste management facility (REGIS site) within the National Park boundary (approx Grid Ref SH 647 021). The site is actually located outside the Park in Machynlleth. It would be appreciated if the Map could be amended prior to final publication
